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The purpose of the afternoon is to explore health in the context of human rights and national and international development. We will bring together expertise from the Universities of Dundee, St Andrews, from NGOs and the health care system to review local, national and international challenges. The event will also include speakers and input from institutions and organisations that are not local. The format of the afternoon will involve a number of short presentations to set the scene followed by discussions, panels and focused workshops around 3 strands 'education', 'research', 'practice'. Thematically, the event will adopt a life course approach and include research that focuses on children, adolescents, families, working age adults and later years. A wide range of topics including ageing in place, disability, migration, war-related trauma, economic and socio-environmental barriers to health care, human rights violations are hoped to be addressed.



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
